1st Home Visit

- Complete the form E-400.
- Complete Family Strengths form FCP-615.
- Complete Enrollment Check list form E-445.
- Obtain any missing information from Application.
- Complete or update Health History form H-331.
- Complete form H-311 Consents and Permissions.
- Complete form H-328 Child Nutritional Assessment.
- Complete or update Lead Screening Questionnaire form H-319.
- Complete USDA Child Enrollment Form
- Review Period 4 COR Family Report and set goals for the child.
- Complete TABS within 45 days of start date or by July 15, 206.

1st Parent Conference

- Complete form E-400.
- Review child's development screening results (PALS, Ages & Stages Questionnaire).
- Review Period 1 COR Family Report and set goals for the child.
- Discuss family goals.
- Discuss transition plans
- Discuss any health concerns (Does the child need any health screenings such as hearing, dental, vision, immunization, lead, Hgb, etc...)
- Obtain emergency contact updates.

2nd Home Visit

- Complete E-400.
- Review Period 2 COR Family Report and update child's goals.
- Update family goals.

- Complete E-400.
- Review Period 3 COR Family Report.

- Discuss transition plans.

- Obtain emergency contact updates.

ASQ's are due within 45 days of enrollment. Children who start June 1st must have ASQ completed by July 15, 2018. Children who start on Aug. 27th must have ASQ's done by Oct. 10th.
