



DIAPERING



- 1) Approved Gloves will always be worn
- 2) Diapering will be done only in a designated diapering area. Food handling will not be permitted in this area
- 3) Surfaces in diapering areas will be kept clean, waterproof and free of cracks, tears and crevices.
- 4) Containers of lotions and cleaning items are to be labeled with child's name and instructions and stored off the diapering surface and out of reach of children.
- 5) Staff will collect all supplies, but keep everything off the diapering surface except the items you will completely use up during the diapering process (use gloves)
- 6) Avoid contact with soiled items and always keep a hand on baby.
- 7) Unfasten the diaper, leaving soiled diaper under child. Hold the child's feet to raise the child out of the soiled diaper and use disposable wipes to clean diaper area. Remove stool and urine from front to back and use fresh wipe each time. Put soiled wipes into the soiled diaper. (Report any skin problems such as redness).
- 8) Remove the soiled diaper, fold diaper over and secure it with the tables and put in covered lined foot pedal operated step can.
- 9) Clean soiled surfaces and then remove gloves and put them in trash can with soiled diaper.
- 10) Wipe hands with disposable wipe
- 11) Put on clean diaper and adjust it.
- 12) Clean baby's hands, using soap and water or water with disposable towels to clean hands. Child is ready to take back to area.
- 13) Clean and disinfect diapering area.
- 14) Wash hands thoroughly.
